

It is quite small, almost 2.75 inches wide and 4 inches long. I have scanned each page and typed up what I could read. I have added punctuation and capital letters.

Great Aunt Aida was 19 years old when she started writing the diary. She turned 20 on November 28, 1881.

Aida was about four years older than her brother, my grandpa, Charles Mortimer Austin.

There are quite a few names mentioned in this little diary. I have included names of relatives at the end of the book.

Special thanks to my husband, Gary Smith, for laying the book out and getting it ready to print.

I hope you enjoy reading this diary as much as I have enjoyed putting the book together.





Friday 14

It has been a fearful day. Maria did not get over. Mr. Gilso called this evening while we were eating supper. He says Tina is sick abed.


Maria was over this afternoon. She stayed to tea. Harry and I went skating this evening.



Saturday 5






My cold is so bad I can hardly see. Lil was around this morning. Her and Ida went over to Macy's.


I sent Becca's valentine today. It was "Looking for a mate." I suppose she will be fearful mad. Maria was over this afternoon. She bought mother a new black dress.
